Notes:

1. Maximum free hours are capped at 6 hours per day of attendance in a week. Free hours are stretched from the term time of 38 weeks during which funding is available to 51 weeks per year during which we are open. These are reflected in the above fees.
2. The “funding” above refers to the 2-year-old funding for working families (and NOT “Together for 2s funding” for families who qualify additional support). If you are eligible for “Together for 2s funding”, please contact us.
3. Parents need to meet the criteria determined by HMRC in order to be eligible for funding.
4. A child becomes eligible for funding at the start of the term after their second birthday, in line with the table below:

When your child turns 2	Will become eligible for a 2-year-old funding from
Between 1 January and 31 March	1 April – start of summer term following their 2 nd birthday
Between 1 April and 31 August	1 September – start of autumn term following their 2 nd birthday
Between 1 September and 31 December	1 January – start of spring term following their 2 nd birthday

Notes:

1. Maximum free hours are capped at:

- 3 hours per day of attendance in a week where a family is eligible for 15-hour funding (universal funding)

- 6 hours per day of attendance in a week where a family is eligible for 30-hour funding (extended entitlement)

Free hours are stretched from the term time of 38 weeks during which funding is available to 51 weeks per year during which we are open. These are reflected in the above fees.

2. Parents need to meet the criteria determined by HMRC in order to be eligible for funding.

3. A child becomes eligible for funding at the start of the term after their third birthday, in line with the table below:

Between 1 January and 31 March	1 April – start of summer term following their 3 rd birthday
Between 1 April and 31 August	1 September – start of autumn term following their 3 rd birthday
Between 1 September and 31 December	1 January – start of spring term following their 3 rd birthday
